

Beach Layout

Supplies:

- Purple Cows Freestyle Cutter
- Zsiage New England Papers:
 - Cape Coral Stripe - JSO428
 - Ocean View - JSO429
- Worldwin ColorMates Cardstock:
 - Dark Chocolate Malt - CCMK12U
 - Light Coffee Brown - CBNL12U
- Zsiage Alphastructures Scrapbook film letters: Prim and Proper 1.5" - Z0226
- Scotch taperunner
- Therm-o-Web Glue Dots
- All Night Media pop Dots
- Tim Holtz alcohol inks by Ranger:
 - Lettuce
 - Latte
 - Stonewashed
- Magic Mesh (Blue)
- Close To My Heart Waxy Flax (Tan)
- Basic Grey Wholy Cow Rub-ons
- Sakura Pigma Micron Black Pen
- Hammermill Transparency



1. Take the 3 colors of alcohol ink, placing a drop of each color on applicator (or small piece of felt) and apply to film letters.
2. Cut a small strip of Ocean View (Green/Blue spattered) paper using the Freestyle Cutter scallop blade with straight-edge cutting guide to fit just inside border of cardstock and attach to page.
3. Cut piece of Ocean View paper (approx. 9.74" x 9.75") using the Freestyle Cutter long wave blade with straight-edge cutting guide and attach to center of page.
4. Cut a circle using the inside of the circle template out of Cape Cod Stripe Paper.
5. Freehand draw two stars for starfish; using the pinking blade, freehand cut outside shape of stars. Then, using the perforated blade, cut in center of each section. Chalk lines with darker brown or ink if desired for dimension.
6. Place photo on page and add titles letter as shown. Place starfish and piece of knotted waxy flax onto circle. Use pop dots for one of the stars. Place folded magic mesh under neath for a beachy look.
7. Add rub-ons to corners of the page.
8. Print journalism onto transparency and place underneath photo.
