

Child Flower Pot

What a great project to do with your child. She/he can grow their own "sweet" flowers. This project uses the Purple Cows Freestyle Decorator #6030, Freestyle cutting mat and the 15" straight edge cutting guide.

Supplies:

- Purple Cows Freestyle Decorator #6030
- Purple Cows Freestyle 15" straight edge cutting guide
- Purple Cows Freestyle cutting mat
- Scrap scrapbook papers
- Glue
- Mini Lollipops
- Xyron Personal Cutting System
- Xyron Personal Cutting System Basic Shapes Design Book (flower #-18)
- Styrofoam (to fit the pot you are using)
- Flower pot 2" x 2" high
- Exacto knife



1. Using Purple Cows Freestyle straight edge cutting guide, cutting mat and pinking cutter, measure and cut strips 3.5" x ½" (how many you need depends on the size of the pot that you use – I used 36).
2. Glue strips, alternating pattern or color strips starting about ½" inside pot.
3. After strips have been glued all the way around the pot, cut a piece of Styrofoam to go inside the pot using the exacto knife and put inside pot.
4. On Freestyle cutting mat, using brown cardstock and the Freestyle pinking cutter, randomly cut strips going back and forth and criss-cross to make "dirt".
5. Glue "dirt" to Styrofoam.
6. Using Xyron Personal Cutting System and Basic Shapes Design Book flower #-18, cut several flowers in coordinating colors. Slip flowers up stick of lollipop and stick lollipop stick into "dirt".
7. Enjoy your flowers!!!!
