

Flower Cuff Bracelets

Supplies:

- Purple Cows Hot Laminating Kit
- Patterned paper
- Cloth flowers
- Snaps or brads
- Hook and Loop Tape (Self-adhesive)
- Craft Strength Adhesive Dots
(We like Zots)



1. Cut patterned paper into strips about two inches wide. Cut the length to fit around the wrist with a 1 1/2" overlap.
2. Laminate the cuff and trim the plastic so that there is no halo around the paper. Purple Cows Hot Laminating Pockets are thin enough to make a wearable, but still durable bracelet.
3. Choose your flowers and stack them as desired. Poke the brad through and open the back of the brad to hold all the layers together. Adhere the cuff using the adhesive dot.
4. Add hook and loop tape to the ends of the cuff for the closure.
