

Freestyle Birthday Card

Bestow Birthday Wishes in a fun and creative way with this easy to make birthday card using the Purple Cows Freestyle Cutter!

Supplies:

- Purple Cows: Freestyle #6010
- DMD Paper Reflections: Purple Gift Sack
- Stampin' Up!: Bold Brights green, and orange Cardstock
- Creative Impressions: Sheer Blossoms flower in orange
- Glitz: Clear Frosting (rhinestones)
- Technique Tuesday: Stars stamp, Happy Birthday Stamp, and black ink
- Rusty Pickle: Birthday Definition Stamp
- Glue Arts: Glue Ring



1. Use the freestyle cutter to trim about 1" off of the open end of the gift sack.
2. Using green cardstock, cut two strips approx. ½" wide each, trim to cover open end of sack. Adhere to sack using glue ring.
3. Fold sack almost in half, so that open end is on top, and not quite meeting the edge of closed end.
4. Adhere flower to top right corner, and put one rhinestone in center of flower
5. Stamp stars on the outside of sack, and then Happy Birthday stamp on green strips.
6. Apply 1 ½" to 2" of rhinestones on bottom left corner
7. Using freestyle, cut a square (don't worry about making it perfect, it looks good crooked!), and stamp stars and Birthday Definition stamp.
