

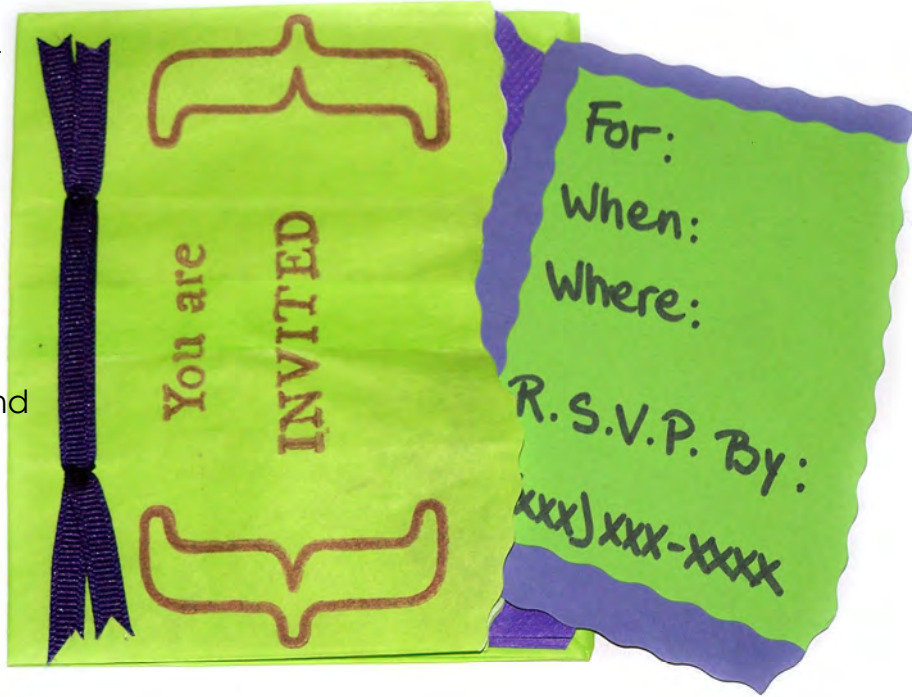
Freestyle Invitation

Buying all matching invitations can be expensive, and you don't always get what you want. Use these easy instructions to create custom invitations for any special occasion!

Supplies:

- Purple Cows: Freestyle #6010
- DMD Paper Reflections: Green Gift Sack
- Stampin' Up!: Bold Brights green, and purple Cardstock
- Offray: Purple Ribbon
- Technique Tuesday: Parentheses stamp, Invited Stamp, and purple ink
- Glue Arts: Glue Ring



1. Use the freestyle cutter to trim about 1" off of the open end of the gift sack.
2. Using purple cardstock, cut one strip approx. 1" wide, trim to cover open end of sack. Adhere to back of sack opening using glue ring.
3. Fold sack almost in half, so that open end is on top (Purple will be between open and closed ends), and not quite meeting the edge of closed end.
4. Punch two small holes approx. 2" apart, and cut two ribbon pieces about 10" long. Thread ribbon, and trim.
5. Stamp front of sack with Parentheses, and "Invited" stamps.
6. Using freestyle, cut a square (Don't worry about making it perfect, it looks good crooked!) out of purple cardstock, and write invitation information on it. Adhere to another piece of cardstock in purple, and trim with freestyle.
