

# Freestyle Pocket Page

This Pocket Page was created on a 6" x 6" piece of paper, but you can use this same easy trick on any page size. This little pocket looks great on tags, cards, and journaling blocks.

## Supplies:

- Purple Cows Freestyle Cutters
- A 2" x 6" strip of decorative paper
- Dry Adhesive



1. Set the Purple Cows Freestyle Cutter to the WAVE blade.
2. Using the cutter, cut a wavy line approximately 1/2" away from each side of the paper strip. Be sure that it is also approximately 3/4" from the top of the strip, this is going to be the opening for the pocket.
3. Add dry adhesive to the back four edges of the paper strip, then adhere to your page. Next, fill the pocket with photos, tags ephemera, or whatever else you'd like to tuck into the page.
4. Embellish the rest of the page. We used American Crafts Greenhouse Flowers, Typehouse, and Mini Marks rub-ons.
