

# Lovely Gift Bottle Label

Give a gift bottle a personal touch with this sweet little label. Personalize it with an initial on the tag, or a private note on the back. Use with a dry erase marker and have the versatility to re-use it!

## Supplies:

- Purple Cows Hot Laminating Kit
- Purple Cows 2 in 1 Combo Trimmer
- Purple Cows Decorative Blades
- Purple Cows Freestyle Cutter
- Purple Cows 4" x 6" Hot Pockets
- Sandylion Patterned Paper  
RMSCH456
- Sandylion Stickers  
PSCB418
- Bazzill Cardstock:  
T2-222 Watermelon
- Stampendous #257U Glitter
- Eyelet's Etc. RDANT Eyelets
- Glue Arts Glue Rings
- Glue Arts MG351 Liquid
- Eyelet Setter
- 1 1/2" Hole Punch



1. Cut cardstock with decorative blade #2808 into a 2.5" x 5.5" piece.
2. Using the same decorative blade, cut the patterned paper to 2" x 5".
3. Using a small amount of glue ring, adhere patterned paper to cardstock.
4. Decorate with glitter, then laminate.
5. Trim laminated piece, and punch 1.5" hole in the top middle.
6. At 2.25" from the top, use the scoring blade of the Freestyle Cutter, and score across. This will make sure the label lies right on the bottle neck.
7. Use the positive piece from the punched hole, and set with eyelet.
8. Apply one or two small stickers to the attached circle to complete your label.
