

# Notebook Insert

A clever way to easily identify your notebook when rushing to class. You won't confuse your notebook with anyone else's either. It is clever, fun and unique. The ring on the side will hold on to your flash drive when you have a report due.

## Supplies:

- Purple Cows Hot Laminator #3020
- Purple Cows Laminator Sheets 12 x 12
- Purple Cows Freestyle cutter straight edge and blade #6020
- Find a fun piece of paper (if notebook has a back get 2 pieces of paper)
- Get a coordinating piece of paper (For the Side of Notebook)
- Embellishments to coordinate
- Eyelet and eyelet setter
- Loose leaf ring
- Card stock to coordinate
- Distressing ink



1. Measure paper to fit all inserts (leave about 1/4" space for laminate)
2. Embellish front of paper
3. Laminate
4. Repeat if you have a back view
5. Measure and fit side panel (leaving about 1/4" space for laminate)
6. Measure 1" down on side panel and 1/2" in from the front
7. Laminate components and insert
8. Set Eyelet (once this is set you cannot remove side panel)
9. Place loose leaf ring into eyelet
