

Poker Coasters

Make a set of awesome – and very fun – coasters for the next party that you are having. You can gear these coasters towards any theme that you fancy – teen room, party favor, any room in your home, it's limitless! We used a miniature deck of cards and used left over scraps of scrapbook paper. (A great way to use up your left-overs box!)

Supplies:

- Purple Cows 13" Hot Laminator #3020
- Purple Cows 12x12" hot sheets #4050
- Purple Cows Freestyle Kit #6000
- Scrap scrapbook papers – (we used left over pieces to match the cards)
- Micro deck of cards (novelty deck)
- Glue



1. Measure strips of paper 1 ½" wide and the same length (I used 12 inch strips) and cut with the Purple Cows Freestyle cutter #6000 kit using the wavy cutter
2. Then glue the strips together leaving 1 inch wide strips. (make 2 strips/pieces)
3. Cut with the Freestyle #6010 wavy edge 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" squares to get 4 squares total.
4. Re-glue any pieces that are loose.
5. Arrange cards on a square in desired pattern and glue (I used royal flushes on one side and on the flip side four of a kind).
6. Repeat for all coasters.
7. Place in hot laminator sheet #4050 and laminate (may need to run through 3 or more times as the cards are wax coated and you want to make sure there is a tight seal for waterproofing).
8. Cut the coasters from the 12 x12 hot laminator sheet #4050 with the Freestyle Cutter #6010 straight edge.
