

Reusable Tags

I love labels on my equipment, boxes, bins, everywhere. These look great and can be coordinated with your rooms décor, but best of all, they can be changed as necessary using a white board marker.

Supplies:

- Purple Cows 2 in 1 Combo Trimmer
- Purple Cows Straight and Deckle Blades
- Purple Cow 13" Hot Laminator
- Purple Cows Hot Laminating Pockets
- Cardstock
- Glue Stick
- Chalks
- Eyelets
- Paper for center of tag (I love the look of the newsprint school lined paper)



1. Cut cardstock to desired tag size using straight blade.
2. Cut paper about ½" smaller than tag using deckle blade.
3. Center and glue paper to tag.
4. Use chalks to shade/age the cardstock and paper.
5. Place tags in Laminator pouch leaving at least ¼" between each tag.
6. Carefully send the pouch through the laminator.
7. Cut out tags, leaving about an eighth inch border of laminate extending from the tag.
8. Set eyelets.
