

Teen Mouse Pad

This is fun, quick and easy to do. Looks great sitting under your mouse. And all your friends are going to want you to make one for them too! I used the Purple Cows Freestyle Kit #6000.!

Supplies:

- Purple Cows 13" Hot Laminator #3020
- Purple Cows 8x8 Hot Pockets #4030
- Purple Cows Freestyle Kit #6000
- Scrap Scrapbook paper (In My Minds Eye)
- Shelf Liner
- Chipboard
- Glue



1. Using the Purple Cows Freestyle Kit #6000 straight cutter, measure and cut 6 x 7.75" chip board and two pieces of paper
2. Glue paper to both sides of the chipboard and let dry
3. Place inside an Purple Cows 8 x 8 Hot Pockets #4030
4. Run through the Purple Cows 13" Hot Laminator #3020 a few times as this will be thick and you want to make sure that the seal is close to the paper and chipboard
5. Trim up
6. Cut shelf liner with Purple Cows Freestyle cutter #6010 to 5.75 x 7.25" and glue to bottom of mouse pad (you will need to pick which side you prefer)
7. Get your mouse and you're ready to compute!
