

"Ultimate" Scraps Card

This is an easy little card to make using all the different blades from PC'. It's great to use your left over scraps of paper for this project.

Supplies:

- Purple Cow's Ultimate Trimmer
 - "Pinking", "Long Wave",
 - "Short Wave", "Victorian",
 - "Colonial", "Deckled"
- 12 x12 White card stock
- 5 x 5" Textured Black Card Stock
- Scrap paper from your stash. I used 3 different bright colors
- Random Scrap paper
- Aquash "Turquoise" Pen from Pentel
- Adhesive



1. With your Ultimate Trimmer and the "Long Wave" blade, trim 6 x 12" with your white card stock. Fold in 1/2" and score.
2. Trim a 5 x 5" piece of black textured cardstock with the "Short Wave" blade. Diva Tip: If you have plain black card stock, you can crumple it up in your hand to make it textured Set aside. You can also cut the black card stock in a shape . I used a heart.
3. Using "Colonial, Victorian, & Deckled" blades, cut various strips of paper 5" long . Cut different widths to give the card more dimension. Adhere and overlap them on your black 5 x 5" square.
4. Using the aquash pen (or ink pad) color over the white card to add a splash of color.
5. Adhere black cardstock to the white card. Send to your favorite Diva!!!!
