

Leather Wallet

The Purple Cows Ultimate Trimmer will not only add a decorative edge to your favorite cardstock and papers, it actually works with real LEATHER, fabric, felt, and ribbon. When using it with leather and other soft materials, just be sure that the guide is locked down, and use a little extra pressure when making the cut.

Supplies:

- Purple Cows Ultimate Rotary Trimmer
- Purple Cows Scallop Blade
- Pliable Leather
- Magnetic Snap Closure



1. With the scallop blade, or any other decorative blade of your choosing, trim your leather to the following sizes: 5" x 4.25" and 1.5" x 4".
2. To the smaller piece of leather, add a very thin line of adhesive to one long end, and two short ends of the piece. Be sure to glue the raw side of the leather. Adhere to the bottom of the larger leather piece. This will be the pocket to hold business cards or photos.
3. Add the magnetic closure to the top and bottom of the larger leather piece as shown.
4. Finally, you can add embellishments such as rub-ons, paint, or even jewels if you'd like.
